Parking reminders

We have been made aware of some unsafe and inconsiderate parking by a small minority of our school community. To show consideration for our local residents and to prevent an accident occurring in the future, please can I remind you of the following:

- It is illegal to park on the zig-zags outside the school
- It is illegal to park on the double yellow lines opposite the school unless you are displaying a blue badge
- Double parking in the lay-by prevents vehicles (including buses and ambulances) from passing along Sandringham Way
- Parking near a road junction is dangerous; the Highway Code states that there should be no parked cars within 10 meters from a junction

Spotlight on KS1...



This week, the spotlight is on our year 1 and 2 classes.

In year 1, we have been really excited to be learning about plants in science! First, we learnt about the difference between natural and man-made things and the different parts of a plant. We are particularly excited to be growing our very own beans in the classroom. We are going to watch the plants as they grow so that we can learn about their leaves, stems and roots.







In year 2, we have been busy acquiring the skills we need to play cricket in PE. We have been learning how to throw underarm and overarm effectively, thinking about our position and stance. We are also how to learning to strike both stationary and moving balls, including the importance of watching the ball. We are looking forward to putting it into practice with some fun cricket games later in the term.
