Topic: Pirate Adventure

The activities below reflect what we would be learning about at this point in the year at school. DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics: Recap the tricky words we've learnt so far. Ask a grown to call out the words for you to practise spelling them - he, she, we, me, my, was, said, for, they, like</p> <p>Maths: Practise directional language with cars/your bike etc. Forwards, backwards, sideways, up, down, turn around, straight... do you know your left and right?</p> <p>Literacy: Write a message in a bottle to a friend who is currently not at school or in your bubble. Write it on a piece of paper, tea stain the letter and then roll it up.</p> <p>Topic: Share the "All About Pirates" presentation (link below) to introduce our topic. Explore the CBeebies website for lots of pirate games, videos and activities!</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics: Play 'Buried Treasure' on Phonics Play practising the digraphs we have learnt.</p> <p>Maths: Listen to the "When you add with a Pirate" song on YouTube (link below) then crack the Pirate code with the attached addition worksheet (link below)</p> <p>Literacy: Design and label a pirate ship - include the jolly roger, the plank, sail etc.</p> <p>Topic: Make your own pirate accessories - hat, sword, eye patches...</p>
Wednesday	<p>Phonics: Practise sentence writing about our topic theme: <i>The flag is black. The ship was big and had a sail. The plank was long and made of wood.</i></p> <p>Maths: Recap coins and money. Identify each of the coins and order them from 1p.</p> <p>Literacy: Read Pirates Love Underpants story (link below) and design your own pair of underpants for a pirate.</p> <p>Topic: Make a treasure map. Ask a friend/family member to follow it to a piece of treasure!</p>
Thursday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Alphablocks" recapping the formation of split digraphs (link below)</p> <p>Maths: Play "coin reveal" using the attached PowerPoint (link below) and listen to the coin song (link below)</p> <p>Literacy: Design a Wanted poster for a pirate describing his features - beard, wooden leg, parrot, stripy top etc.</p> <p>Topic: Join in with Cosmic Yoga (link below)</p>
Friday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Phonics Pirates" (link below) to practise digraphs</p> <p>Maths: Discuss the value of coins and complete the attached template</p> <p>Literacy: Practise split digraph "a-e" matching the words and pictures (attached)</p> <p>Topic: Dance along to the "Pirate Gang" song with Boogie Beebies</p>
