Topic: Space Adventure

DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Mr Thorne Does Phonics" revisiting the split digraph a-e (link below). Change words mat-mate/hat-hate/tap-tape/mad-made recognising a-e in each word.</p> <p>Maths: Play "Blast Off" number game with numbers 0-20 (link below)</p> <p>Literacy: Read the story 'Whatever Next' (link below) and write a list of what you would choose to take on a journey to the moon. Remember to include numbers as a list when you write your ideas.</p> <p>Topic: Make a rocket out of junk modelling materials. What can you add to make the features of your rocket? If you have one available, use a cardboard box for your own pretend play. What would you use a cardboard box for?</p>
Tuesday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Mr Thorne Does Phonics" revisiting the split digraph e-e (link below). Practise spelling Pete, Eve, evening, these, theme, extreme</p> <p>Maths: Practise counting backwards from 10. Can you try backwards from 20? Write the numbers down first if this would help.</p> <p>Literacy: Revisit the 'Whatever Next' story. Can you remember what happened at the beginning, then next and at the end? Practise sentence writing by recalling what you can remember. Remember to add a full stop and finger spaces to your writing.</p> <p>Topic: Have a teddy bears picnic with one of your bears. What do you need to bring? Write an invitation to your bear and any family members that might like to join you.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Mr Thorne Does Phonics" revisiting the split digraph i-e (link below).</p> <p>Maths: Draw around and cut out some 2D shapes on different coloured paper - circle, triangle, square etc. Put them together to make your own rocket picture.</p> <p>Literacy: Use Phonics Play 'obb and bob' to identify real and alien words (link below). Design your own aliens and give him/her a nonsense name. Remember to sound it out afterwards: i.e w-ur-b = Wurb the alien or k-ow-t = Kowt the alien</p> <p>Topic: Introduce the Solar System (link below). Discuss what you already know with an adult. Scribe a list of questions for what you would like to find out more about. Listen to the song about the planets (link below).</p>
Thursday	<p>Phonics: Watch "Mr Thorne Does Phonics" revisiting the split digraph o-e (link below). Play digraph bingo using the following digraphs/split digraphs to choose from: a-e, e-e, i-e, o-e, ue, oo, oi, ar, ou, ur</p> <p>Maths: Practise the names of different 3D shapes we know - cube, cuboid, sphere, prism. Use the PowerPoint link below to help you find examples of real objects around your house that are these shapes.</p> <p>Literacy: Learn the order of the planets in the solar system. Refer back to yesterday's song if this would help. Use the template below to order them correctly. Can you write the names of the planets too?</p>

	Topic: Create some space art work, using watercolour wash for the background. Use chalk, crayon or pens to draw some planets and the moon. Add them to your watercolour wash once it's dry.
Friday	<p>Phonics: Listen to the 'magic e' song on YouTube to consolidate this week's sounds. Adult to read the following sentences out loud for the children to scribe. Children to use their phonics/key word recall independently: <i>I like to bake cakes, Pete saw the moon in the evening, The clock tells the time just fine, I hope that dog gets his bone.</i></p> <p>Maths: Use the link below to colour the picture according to the 3D shapes</p> <p>Literacy: Read the "Back to Earth with a bump" story and complete some of the resource packs attached to the link below.</p> <p>Dance: Dance along to Boogie Beebies 'Space Walking' (link below)</p>
