RECEPTION - HEDGEHOGS AND MOLES

Week Beginning: 13/7/20

Topic: Transition and Moving On

The activities below reflect what we would be learning about at this point in the year at school. Remember though - you don't have to do it all; you can adapt it however you like and most importantly have fun and send us pictures of what you do! We know everyone has different circumstances at home and you need to make the home learning work for your family.

DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Monday	<p>Phonics: Recap all of the sounds, actions, digraphs and trigraphs we have learnt in Reception this year. Spend this week revising your favourite phonics games and activities; phonics play, tricky words song, alphablocks, tricky word bingo etc.</p> <p>Literacy: Add a page to our class book ready for the new Reception children joining Moles and Hedgehogs in September (template below). Write a sentence telling the new children something about Reception. "Henry the hedgehog is the class pet" or "The playground has a trim trail".</p>
Tuesday	<p>Circle Time: Read "The Huge Bag of Worries" story (link below) to identify the feeling of worry. Discuss how this feeling is ok and together talk about the transition to Year 1. What could be the same? What might be different? Is there anything you are worried about in moving on? Reflect on the year in Reception. Look at the school website and follow the links to the Year 1 classes pages and the gallery to see if you can see some of the activities you can look forward to in Year 1.</p> <p>Maths: Play "Chopper Squad" (link below) recapping one more/one less than numbers from 1-10, then 1-20 and beyond if you're ready.</p>
Wednesday	<p>Literacy: Write a letter to your new teacher telling them 3 things about you... you could use the 'spread my wings and fly' transition template attached. Your letter could include: your name, your family members, your favourite animal or colour, your favourite thing about Sandringham. You might like to add a picture of yourself too!</p> <p>PE: We sadly missed Sports Day this year, but you could practise running races, egg and spoon or an obstacle course at home, in the park or on the playground. Make medals/certificates to award prizes for first, second or third place in the running race!</p>
Thursday	<p>PSHE: Watch Topsy and Tim's first day at school (link below) reflecting on what it was like starting school.</p> <p>Art: Paint your self portrait so your new teacher knows what you look like. Don't forget to use a mirror if you're not sure what colour eyes you have. Look carefully - is your hair long or short? Do you have freckles? Do you wear glasses?</p>
Friday	<p>Celebration: Children at home look back through your Tapestry journal with someone in your family. Celebrate all that you have enjoyed/learnt/achieved this year in Reception... we will do the same in school. Save and download your journal over the coming week so you can treasure your Reception year forever. We will notify you when it is ready!</p>


