### RECEPTION - HEDGEHOGS AND MOLES

**Week Beginning:** 4/1/21

**Topic Theme:** Winter

Described below are some suggested activities for home learning that we hope will structure you and your child's day. The activities are related to our topic and reflect what we would be learning about at this point in the year in Reception. Please remember this structure must be flexible and accommodate your child's needs and interests – feel free to adapt it however you like and most importantly have fun and send us pictures of what you do! We know everyone has different circumstances at home and you need to make the home learning work for your family. Remember each day to allocate time to play, for reading, physical activity etc. Remember to also include an act of kindness; tidy your toys, help lay the table, help unload the dishwasher, read a story to a younger sibling etc.

DAY	DAILY ACTIVITIES
Wednesday	<p><b>Phonics:</b> Make your own set of phonics cards using paper, post it notes etc. Write the following sounds (one on each card): <b>s, a, t, i, p, n, g, o, c, k, e, u, r, m, d, h, l, f, b, j, v, w, x, y, z</b> and then use these to talk to an adult about the game we play in school called "My Turn Your Turn". Practise saying each of the sounds on the cards in turn.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Recap the numbers to 10 and make your own number line for counting. Practise your number formation to ensure your numbers are the right way round! (see link below). Challenge yourself to write numbers beyond 10 if you feel you can.</p> <p><b>Literacy:</b> Listen to the Percy the Park Keeper story "One Snowy Night" (see link below) and talk about the features of winter in the story. What can you see in the pictures? How do you know it is Winter?</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> As part of your daily exercise, go for a Winter Walk with a grown up. Spot the signs of Winter and talk about what you can see, hear, smell and feel.</p>
Thursday	<p><b>Phonics:</b> Use your sound cards to practise each sound first (My Turn Your Turn) then put three sounds together to make simple words. Adult to say the following words for children to spell out... <b>cup, jug, zip, fox, yes, kit</b>. Challenge yourself with four letter words if you feel ready... <b>frog, hand, clap</b>.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Play the "fruit splat" game online to practise addition... see link below.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> Ask an adult to freeze three bags of water and watch throughout the day as they turn into ice! Discuss the idea of 'melting' and think of ways to melt the ice. What would be the quickest way to melt the ice? What would slow the process down? Take photographs of your experiment over the next few hours/days.</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> Create a wintry art picture using art and craft material from around your house – this could include painting, collage, playdough etc. What colours will you need? What textures might you explore?</p>
Friday	<p><b>Phonics:</b> Play "Tricky Word Song" (link below) and practise our key words. Can you put them each into a sentence... I am good at running. I went <b>to the</b> shop... etc.</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> Go on a number hunt around your house looking for all the numbers 0-10. Make a list first and tick them off as you go. Can you find numbers on a clock, television, microwave etc.</p> <p><b>Literacy:</b> Make a hot chocolate drink with a grown up. Write a list of what you needed to make this and take a picture to show us whether you liked it or not!</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> Dress someone in the family in winter clothes i.e. hat, gloves, scarf etc. Time how long it takes you to do this at speed. Is it quicker to dress yourself in these items or someone else?</p>
