From Monday 12th February, SGN have been upgrading their gas networks. These works are due to last for approximately 12 weeks and will involve the following changes:

- Grove Cross Road will be closed from Monday 12th February, along with temporary two-way traffic lights on Church Road for approximately two weeks.
- Temporary three-way traffic lights along Church Road at its junction of Apex Drive will then be used.

If these road works are likely to disrupt your travel plans to school in the morning or afternoon, please adjust your timings accordingly, as we expect all children to arrive at their classroom between 8:40am and 8:50am.

If you and your child arrive after 8:50am, we ask that you go straight to the office to sign in and enter the building via the office. Upon arrival at the office, please give a reason for the lateness, which will be added to the register. Your child will then walk, or be escorted, to their classroom.

#### **Penalty charge notices**

If you take your child out of school without authority, you will be liable to receive a penalty notice. Currently, the amount payable under the penalty notice is £60 per parent/carer per child if paid within 21 days. Thereafter, the amount increases to £120 if paid within 21 to 28 days. If this remains unpaid after 28 days, the local authority may consider a prosecution in the Magistrate's Court. Since penalty notices are issued per parent/carer per child, a family of two parents and two children will receive four penalty notices. This is not a source of income for the school and is dealt with directly by Surrey County Council.




# World Book Day Thursday 7th March

There is absolutely no expectation that costumes are bought – every child's outfit will be celebrated, as we are celebrating all kinds of books, characters, authors and illustrators on this day!







#### Normal clothes costumes:


- Harry Harry and the Bucketful of Dinosaurs by Ian Whybrow: normal clothes + bucket + toy dinosaurs
