We are looking forward to celebrating our PE skills with you during **Sports Day on Friday 21st June - starting at 9.40am**. Please refer to the information below to help us all enjoy our day!

The children have been grouped into six coloured teams and will get together in these teams next week to meet their team mates. Each team will have a name chosen by the children and will be led by captains from our Sports Council. For the first part of Sports Day the children will take part in a rotation of six track and field events. They will compete as a team, scoring points at each event. There will be a short break after three events where the children will return to the classrooms for a snack, drink and toilet break. The teams will then come back out to complete the remaining team activities. Please note that there will be no refreshments provided by the school for spectators, so please bring your own drink and snack to have on the playground!

After all six events have taken place the children will be taken back to their own class where they will get ready for lunch. We will be having a whole school picnic lunch together on the field and we would like to invite you to join us. Please bring a packed lunch with you as we will not be providing lunches for spectators. The children will come out with their class teacher onto the field, eat their lunch with you and have a short playtime.

Children can either have a packed lunch with you or order one through school prior to the event. There will be no hot meals available on this day.

At 1pm a bell will be rung and the children will line up on the playground to come back into their own classrooms for registration. You are then invited onto the field to watch class sprint races. After the races, an awards ceremony will take place. Following the awards ceremony, the children will return to their classrooms to change out of their team t-shirts back into their PE t-shirt.

If you would like to collect your child after the award ceremony at approximately 2.30pm, please wait outside your child's classroom at the usual pick up point. **You will need to have pre-signed the attached permission slip if you would like to take your child early and must only take your child from the class teacher and not before they have returned to the classrooms to collect their belongings.** School will however continue to run as usual until 3.10pm.

The children will need to come into school wearing their school PE kit (t-shirt, shorts, plimsolls or trainers that fit). They will need to bring their school cap and a named water bottle with them. Book bags will not be needed.

On the day, the children will need to be registered in their classroom as usual. Outside the main gate by the Nursery, you will find a map showing where each event will be taking place and where each team will start. Once you have dropped your child off or when you are ready, please make your way to the field/playground. We are aiming to start the first event as near to 9.40am as possible. The children will be wearing coloured t-shirts (which we have provided) to match their team. Once the children come out with their teams, you are welcome to follow your child's group around the events. Please be aware of the other events taking place when choosing a place to stand. Can we remind you that it is the responsibility of staff to manage the behaviour of the children? Please don't offer your child food or drink during the events or take them away from their team. Should a child need to go to the toilet then a member of staff will supervise this. Thank you for your co-operation.

Please could we ask that you park considerately on Sports Day. Please do not block neighbours' driveways, double park or park on the double yellow lines or zig zags. There is plenty of parking available at Frimley recreation ground. Any cars parked without consideration will be asked to move.

We hope that you will enjoy cheering, whooping and celebrating sport with us at Sandringham! Please feel free to speak to us if you have any questions.
